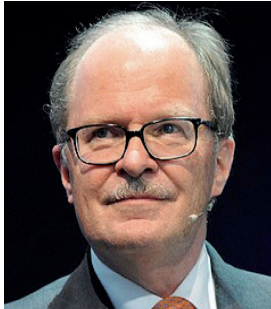

Christian Gerber, MD, FRCS(hon) is Professor and Chairman em of the Department of Orthopaedics at the University of Zürich. After Medical School at Berne and Yale, he underwent medical training in Neurology, Internal Medicine, General Surgery and then Orthopaedics in Berne, Paris, and San Antonio. He was appointed Professor and Chair at the Cantonal Hospital Fribourg in 1992 and to the University of Zürich in 1995. He received a honorary degree of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, is member of the Swiss Academy of medical Sciences and has authored over 400 peer – reviewed publications. He is the only four time winner of the Charles S. Neer Award, the first non-American winner of the Kappa Delta Award of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons and recipient of the Arthur Steindler Award of the Orthopaedic Research Society. In 2000 he created the ResOrtho Foundation for Orthopaedic Research and Education which has supported young academic careers and contributed to Balgrist Campus, a novel infrastructure for orthopaedic research and development.
