Michael Grotzer studied medicine at the University of Zurich. In addition to his specialization in pediatrics, he is also certified in pediatric oncology-hematology. At the University Children's Hospital Zurich, he worked as a resident in pediatrics from 1993 to 1996 and as a senior physician in oncology and general pediatrics from 1996 to 1997. Subsequently, he spent three years as a research fellow at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, University of Philadelphia (USA). He returned to the University Children's Hospital of Zurich in 2000 as a senior physician, where he was promoted to chief physician in 2004, co-division head of oncology in 2010, and head of the Center for Oncology, Hematology, Immunology and Stem Cell Transplantation in 2013. In 2018, he was appointed Full Professor at UZH and Medical Director of the University Children's Hospital Zurich.

Michael Grotzer has been the recipient of numerous awards for his research activities. Among others, he has received the Friedrich Götz Prize of the University of Zurich and the SIOP Prize (International Society of Pediatric Oncology).
