He has held senior leadership positions as CEO of the Berlin Institute of Health, Founding Director of the Digital Health Center at the Hasso Plattner Institute, Co-Director of the Hasso Plattner Institute for Digital Health at Mount Sinai, and CEO of the Wyss Center for Bio and Neuroengineering in Geneva.

Author of more than 400 scientific publications with over 83,000 citations, Dr. Böttinger is recognized for building world-class organizations at the intersection of medicine, AI, and innovation. Today, through EPB Sàrl, he advises, invests in, and helps build transformative ventures in brain health, neurotechnology, precision medicine, and next-generation healthcare.
